



STATISTICS FROM POINT-IN-TIME COUNT JANUARY 2014

- There were 391 surveys recorded with 508 people in households, 415 of which were adults and 93 children.
- 66% were men.
- The average age of children was seven years old.
- 8.6% responded that they had served in the Armed Forces.
- The top two reasons for homelessness were addiction and unemployment.
- 25.6% did not graduate from high school.
- The top three responses to where they spent the last night's lodging were Emergency Shelter (27%), incarcerated (25%) and in a place not meant for habitation (18%).
- 23.1% reported receiving dental care, compared to 13.5% the previous year.
- The top reasons given for disabilities were substance abuse, chronic physical illness and serious mental illness.
